# *The National Parks of Kenya*

## *The Masai Mara National Reserve* "THE GREATEST WILDLIFE SHOW ON EARTH"

World renowned for the breathtaking spectacle of the annual migration of half a million wildebeest, the Mara is Kenya's most visited protected area. Technically an extension of Tanzania's renowned Serengeti National Park, the Mara constitutes only 4% of the entire Serengeti ecosystem but its rolling grasslands, meandering rivers and towering escarpments offer one of the world's most rewarding and evocative wildlife arenas. Offering an abundance of herbivores, the Mara makes the ideal hunting ground for Kenya's famous 'big cats' and hosts her largest population of lions. Historically teeming with wildlife, the Mara is famous for the large herds of elephant and buffalo that meander its plains; also for the fat pods of hippo that wallow in its mud-brown rivers.

## *Lake Nakuru National Park* "SHIMMERING MIRAGE, FLAMING REALM"

Entitled 'the greatest bird spectacle on earth' thanks to the millions of fuchsia-pink flamingo that flock to feed on the teeming algae of its alkaline waters, the pink-frosted shores and sky-mirrored waters of Lake Nakuru yield some of the most evocatively beautiful photo-images in Africa. Small in size, but high in wildlife, this park makes the ideal day trip, enroute to other destinations and abounds in picturesque lookouts and picnic spots. As Kenya's first and largest rhino sanctuary, sightings of both black and white rhino are almost guaranteed, while plentiful waterbuck, warthog, zebra, gazelle and buffalo graze the shoreline. Echoing to the haunting cries of the numerous fish eagles, this is also the park in which you have the best chance of seeing a leopard.



### **BORANA LODGE**

The Lodge looks over the Samangua Valley with its own lake where elephants love to swim. The 8 cottages, unique in style but all comfortable and cozy, with fire places and private verandas.

**Activities:** A stunning horizon pool ideal for relaxing, horse riding adventures, land rovers for game drives, amory leads bush walks, breakfasts with the Dyer family who provide family History, while private picnics, sundowners, massage, bush dinners, cattle ranch with Michael Dyer or fly-fish on the mountain and take a helicopter trip around Mt Kenya or into the northern frontier.



### **NORTHERN SLOPES OF MT KENYA**

#### **SIRIKOI**

Sirikoi is a beautiful game lodge built on the northern slopes of Mt Kenya on private land surrounded by the Lewa Wildlife conservancy. Has four luxury ensuite tents and a luxury cottage with two ensuite bedrooms.

**Activities:** infinity pool, enjoy some of the best game viewing in East Africa, evening sundowner with mountain view, opt for a helicopter trip, lion tracking, horseback riding, picnic and visit Masai home stead.



### **TSAVO EAST NATIONAL PARK**

#### **SATAO CAMP**

Set in a unique location, in the heart of the Tsavo East National Park, nestled amongst Tamarind trees and surrounding a central water hole. The accommodation consists of 4 luxury suites, one of which is the honeymoon and VP suite with its own bath, six family tents and 10 standard tents, one of which is equipped for guests physically challenged

## **TSAVO EAST NATIONAL PARK**

### **GALDESSA CAMP**

This small eco-tourism camp is set in the middle of Tsavo East National Park, with high standards of accommodation and service. From day and night game drives in the open vehicles to walking safaris along the Galana River in Tsavo East National Park and wild luxurious meals in the bush, the experienced and enthusiastic staff at Galdeessa know how to make each day unique and exciting.

## **MASAI MARA**

### **LITTLE GOVERNORS CAMP**

An intimate in character, with just 17 luxury en-suite tents tucked around a large watering hole that teems with both birds and wildlife. The camp is approached by a boat ride across the Mara River, then an escorted walk through the riverine forest. Vehicles are left on the far river bank, and the camp is therefore quiet and undisturbed.

The guest tents at Little Governors' have recently been renovated and now have great wooden decks with large verandahs for guests to enjoy the constant game activity that takes place around the watering hole of the camp.

## **MASAI MARA**


### **OLARRO CAMP**

Location south western Kenya in the Laikipia Hills Massif. Olarro (Masai word for Buffalo) situated on a 10,000 acre private conservancy on the 150,000 acre Maji Moto Group Ranch, owned by the local Masai people. The conservancy sits along the corridor of the annual wildebeest migration. Main Olarro has 7 cottages (3 twin and 4 double rooms).

## **MASAI MARA**

### **OL SEKI MARA CAMP**

Located in Eastern Kenya, operates on an all inclusive basis. Nina tent boasts of queen sized bed, plus large sofa bed and sitting area. Ensuite shower, bathroom and changing area. Each tent is made of twelve panels, surrounded by a stunning wooden decking, providing guests with a 270 degrees view of the plains below.





## MASAI MARA

### TILPILIKWANI LUXURY CAMP

Tilpikwani Camp is set on the banks of the Talek River in Masai Mara surrounded by endless plains and acacia tree. Tilpikwani, a small and exclusive camp of 20 luxury tents - all furnished in rustic two design camp and lodge style offers all the luxury comforts expected. The camp exudes warm and rich colors of Africa. Fine food, personalized service and traditional African hospitality compliment its beautiful location.

**Activities:** Guided night game drive, Guided Bush/Nature walk, Balloon safari with bubbly breakfast, Bush breakfast, Sundowner, Bush dinner, Game drives in 4 wheel drive vehicle.



## MASAI MARA

### KAREN BLIXEN CAMP

The camp is set on the banks of the Mara River with an undisturbed view to the impressive Cirokolo Escarpment in the front. The camp comprises of 22 large tents set on large mahogany platforms – each with a spacious veranda complete with a cushion daybed from which one can enjoy an afternoon siesta or simply relax taking in the wonderful surroundings. Each tent can be configured to either double or twin occupancy, en-suite and has a bathroom with flush toilets, twin wash hand basins and an outside shower with looks to the sky.

**Activities:** game walks, nature walks, balloon safari, community visits, family activities and eco awareness tour.



## MASAI MARA

### RICHARDS CAMP

Positioned on the edge of the forest, overlooking the Masai Mara Plains, many species of the wildlife are regular visitors to the camp. The camp is secluded and intimate. 7 tents, perfect for small groups and family holidays. Each room has 24 hour solar lighting and en-suite bathrooms with flushing lavatories and hot showers. Guests can indulge in an open air Victorian bath tucked away in the forest.

Richard's Private Camp: the 10 beds in this camp are booked on an exclusive basis only.

**Activities:** spectacular game viewing, guided bush walks, picnics, sundowners, see a sanctuary of the rare white rhino and take a scenic flight or day trip to Lake Victoria.



## LAKE BARINGO ISLAND

### SAMATIEN ISLAND

Samatian Island is an eco-lodge set on a small private island with breathtaking views across the bronze waters of Lake Baringo. 6 unique thatched rooms, accommodate 12 to 16 guests. Two of these rooms are family units.

**Activities:** boat ride around the island, home to multitude of birds, lizards, hippos and crocodiles, bird-watching with professional guides or bush-walk within the Ruko Community Conservancy. Visit the Njemps village and schools, enjoy bush breakfast and sundowners, mountain bike, fish, canoe or experience a variety of water sports including : wake-boarding, water skiing, knee-boarding and tubing. Massage and participate in community projects that help local schools.





## SHABA

### JOYS CAMP

Located on Joy Adamson's (of 'Elsa the Lioness' fame) original camp site, this camp is a departure from both traditional tented camp style and rustic lodge style (and no doubt bears little resemblance to Joy's actual camp which is slightly paradisaical). However, it's beautifully designed, clean and refreshing, with broad pale-canvas roofs which give the rooms a light, airy look. There are large bedrooms, private verandahs overlooking the surrounding bush and spacious bathrooms.



## TSAVO WEST NATIONAL PARK

### FINCH HATTONS

Privately owned and managed, Finch Hattons is one man's dream to create an ideal, offering guests a unique opportunity to relive the golden era of the safari with elegance, first class comforts and the finest cuisine surrounded by the spectacle of the great African wilderness.

The Finch Hatton camp accommodates up to 50 people in spacious safari tents attractively constructed in light beige canvas with large "windows", wooden flooring and a permanent thatched roof.



## MASAI MARA

### ROYAL MARA SAFARI LODGE

The Royal Mara has six luxury, spacious, guest suites situated with river frontage which have flush toilets, bidets, twin basins, luxury showers, hot water, and electricity. All river guest suites have luxury hand carved furnishings, elegant linen, lush towels, bathrobes, slippers, toiletries, and four poster beds (one super king or two doubles; additional bedding added if desired) and are supplied with umbrellas, raincoats, and insect repellent. They also have Maasai carpeting, colonial antiques, and African artifacts and include a wardrobe armoire cabinet, a writing desk, a safe deposit box, a mini bar stocked with complimentary drinks and an internal sitting area. A personal butler is assigned to each river guest suite and daily house keeping is provided.



## NORTHERN FRONTIER

### SARARA CAMP

Sarara is a community owned property which should be commended for persistence in hanging in through some fairly tough times. The lodge is on a raised escarpment overlooking a bowl of scrubby old land surrounded by the dramatic creases of the Matthew's Range. Its tents, each with open air bathrooms and private verandahs complimented by a natural rock swimming pool which itself is perched above the waterhole that attracts a good variety of game throughout the day.

**Activities:** game drives, walking safaris, hiking in the rain forest, donkey trek, bush picnics and sundowners. A night or two's flycamping, as part of a short camel trek are also a feature of the place.



#### MUGIE CAMP

Tucked away on a private ranch within the vast 9,000 sq. kilometer Laikipia Plains is Mugie Camp. 4 spacious double tents with toilet and shower, all drinks (except champagne) & laundry inclusive.

**Activities:** game drives in four wheel drive vehicles, guided nature walks, horseback riding, camel walks, bush breakfast, picnics and sundowners, night game drives, donkey treks to the edge of the Rift Valley



#### SAMBURU EWASO NYIRO RIVER

##### LEMARTI'S CAMP

Lemarti's Camp is an unforgettable safari hideaway in Kenya's breathtaking Northern Laikipia plateau. One of the last frontiers of virgin wilderness and home to the majestic Samburu people. The camp was built and run by local Samburu guide, Loyapan Lemarti and his Kenyan based fashion designer wife Anna Trzebinski.

**Activities:** Guests walk into the wilderness with Samburu warriors armed only with their traditional weapons and expertise, game viewing, guided walks, track big game on foot, ornithological paradise, camel trekking, mountain bikes, visit women groups activities and attend ceremonies that are taking place.



#### AMBOSELI

##### SATAO ELERAJ

Satao Eleraj situated in its own private wildlife conservancy between Amboseli and Mt Kilimanjaro. Has 5 lodge style suite rooms and 9 deluxe tents, designed to ensure that your stay will be complete luxury. Each tent has its own ensuite bathroom with hot showers and toilet with a view. The elegantly furnished suite rooms have large sliding door that opens out onto your own private veranda overlooking Amboseli National Park and the plains below.

**Activities:** game walks, bush sundowners, day and night game drives, community village visits and bush dinners in remote and unique locations.



#### AMBOSELI

##### TORTILIS CAMP

Named after the Tortilis Acacia (the Umbrella Thorn Tree), a charming rustic tented camp built into the side of a hill, facing the foothills of Africa's highest mountain, Kilimanjaro. As you walk into camp, your first view across the tree-studded plains towards the snow-capped mountain stops you in your tracks. The camp nestles in abundant trees and shrubs, bustling with bird life.



## MASAI MARA

### MARA PLAINS

The Olare Orok Conservancy offers true win-win for the predators and wildlife of the area. Mara Plains Camp is situated along the Mlakaletk River with uninterrupted views of the surrounding plains. Each of the 6 rooms has en-suite bathroom facilities including hot and cold water, a flush toilet and shower.

**Activities:** game viewing in 4 x 4 landcruisers, exclusive walking safaris and special night game drives.



## MERU NATIONAL PARK

### ELSA'S KOPJE

A private hideaway perched on top of Mugwongo Hill, site of George Adamson's first camp. From your private cottage, placed well away from your neighbor, you will enjoy 270degree view of the surrounding park with its scattered kopjes and delightful baobab trees. Located within Meru National Park, 8 stone and thatched cottages – 2 twin beds and 6 king-sized beds.

**Activities:** swimming pool, game drives in 4WD open vehicles, guided nature walks, night game drives, fishing, rafting on the Tana River, bush breakfast, picnics and sundowners.



## LAKE NAKURU

### MBWEHA LUXURY COTTAGES

Tucked away in the spectacular vastness of the Great Rift Valley on a private 6400 acre Congreve Conservancy, Mbweha Camp is nestled up against the southern border of Lake Nakuru National Park with beautiful views of Eburu and Mau Ranges. 10 cottages built of lava stone and thatched makuti roof add glamour and style to its contemporary African ambience.

**Activities:** bush walks, night game drives, sundowners, bush breakfast and hot ballooning over the great Rift Valley.



## SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE

### ELEPHANT BEDROOM CAMP

Set on the banks of the Ewaso Nyiro River in Samburu National Reserve surrounded by dourm palms and other beautiful indigenous trees and shrubs sits this small and exclusive camp of 12 luxury tents- all furnished in rustic African style while offering all the comforts expected of a luxury Camp. Hot and cold water, electricity and herbal products.



#### LAKE NAIVASHA

##### LOLDIA HOUSE

On shore of the Lake Naivasha , situated on a privately owned ranch 8,000 acres. Accommodation in the main house or in cottages in the garden. Cottages are ideal for honeymooners. All rooms have stunning view of Lake Naivasha.

**Activities:** boat trips on Lake Naivasha and Crescent Island, walks on the farm with our residential naturalist, game viewing on the farm, visit Loldia School, visit local flower farms, Golf , tennis and night game drives.



#### EWASO NYIRO

##### EL KARAMA

El Karama is located in the heart of Laikipia. 14,000 acres of prime game land with over 75 species of mammals and 350 species of birds. The Lodge has 6 bandas and cottages along the acacia clad banks of the Ewaso Nyiro River.

**Activities:** day and night game drives, horse safaris with El Karama's own horses, walking safaris with ranch trackers and fishing in the Ewaso Nyiro River.



#### MASAI MARA

##### SHOMPOLE

Shompole overlooks the sweeping grass plains, acacia woodland and volcanic mountains of the Great Rift Valley, a unique destination. Each room is individually designed around the natural contours of the hillside and encompasses a fusion of quartz rock, pale thatch smooth fig-wood and flowing white walls. Water flows through the rooms into private plunge pools beside which you can relax on spacious sofas. Little Shompole is the place to be! Two stunning suites of incredible proportions with 9 x 9 beds, large private cool-pools, sun decks and spacious bathroom nestle against the hillside.

**Activities:** massage, morning walks, bike rides, trips to see the flamingos of Lake Naivasha, game drive in the conservancy and night game drives.



#### MASAI MARA

##### NAIBOR

The Masai word for space, whiteness and clarity, is a camp that has been designed to offer the opportunity to escape the hustle of modern life to a quiet corner of the famed Masai Mara Game Reserve. Comfortable king-sized beds, 6 double tents and 3 twin tents, ensuite bathroom with flush toilets and safari showers. Little Naibor has two suites each containing 1 double and 1 twin with communal living and dining area with private fire place.

**Activities:** game viewing, hot air ballooning, massage and spa treatment.





## MASAI MARA

### OLONANA

Situated on the banks of the picturesque Mara River is Olonana, a premier bush camp whose unique location offers remarkable opportunity for safari adventures. Features 12 spacious, permanent bush pavilions, each tastefully appointed with two comfortable queen-size tents, en-suite bathrooms with showers, and large river view terraces.

**Activities:** guided game drives, escorted bush walks and tracking, Masai cultural experience, bush picnics and traditional sundowners.



## GREAT RIFT VALLEY

### MALEWA WILDLIFE LODGE + KIGIO WILDLIFE CAMP

Kigio Wildlife Conservancy 3,500 acres between Nakuru and Naivasha. Set within the glorious Yellow Acacia woodland along the Malewa River is Malewa Wildlife Lodge with 5 individual and traditional-styled buildings with 6 bedrooms (one is a 2 story family cottage with 2 rooms) and 4 stunning river suites on stilts (including one honeymoon suite with outdoor bath). All offering spacious bedrooms with en-suite bathrooms within an acacia forest filled with wildlife. Kigio Wildlife Camp is 1 km from Malewa Wildlife Lodge, has 11 spacious suites and 2 bed-roomed family suite, each built on deck and containing a large bedroom and sitting area, a private bathroom with flush loo, shower and balcony.

**Activities:** game walks with naturalist, biking and fishing, community visits.



## LAKE NAIVASHA

### ENASHIPAI RESORT & SPA

Enashipai a Masai word meaning a state of happiness. Enashipai Resort & Spa is located within the splendor of the Great Rift Valley and by the shores of Lake Naivasha, the second largest fresh water lake in Kenya. 40 luxurious Suites, 6 standard rooms and exclusive 4 room palm cottage with private living room. All rooms have internet, mini bars and flat screen TVs with premium entertainment channels.

**Activities:** kids club, fitness center, swimming pool, mountain climbing, hiking, biking or even bird watching and Boat Rides on Lake Naivasha.



## LAKE VICTORIA

### MFANGANO ISLAND CAMP

Lapped by the waters of Lake Victoria, the world's second largest fresh water lake and source of the Nile, Mfangano Island Camp is an oasis of tranquility. ## KENYA – NEW TERRITORIES


### TANA DELTA DELTA DUNES LODGE

Nestled amongst the sand dunes and dourm palms that run north from Malindi, are 6 open fronted "castaway" style rooms, with all the ultimate comforts. Afterno dining and lounging with 360 degree views around, serving ice cold drinks and delicious freshly caught seafood. From the camp you are able to explore the Delta wetlands which are diverse as they are unique and fragile, with amazing birdlife and large numbers of hippos & crocodiles. Enjoy 35kms of uninterrupted deserted beaches and miles of rippling, rolling sand dunes, all to yourself. Creek fishing, kayaking and sand yachting are some of the activities that are on offer.



### DESERT ROSE LODGE

Nestled on the Southern slopes of sacred Mount Nyiru, Desert Rose commands views over the vast rugged skylines near a spring-fed forest in Kenya's fragile semi arid Northern wilderness. They have ensured every aspect of the lodge is totally environmentally friendly, from your hot bath water of which there is plenty to the disposal of waste. The five houses accommodating up to twelve people are individually designed around various natural features. Each suite has its own private flush toilet and open air en-suite bathroom. The main lounge and pool area have been hand crafted to blend with the indigenous gardens, landscaped to enhance the dramatic views and all the power is solar generated.



### SABUK LODGE

A haven on the edge of the Laikipia plateau, overlooking the Ewaso Nyiro River and the plains of Laikipia towards Mount Kenya. The Laikipia plateau stretches from the foothills of the Aberdares, across vast open plains to the Northern Frontier District and the Mathews Range. The region nurtures exceptional wildlife and cultural diversity, home to many communities including the Laikipiak Maasai and the Samburu tribes. Around Sabuk Lodge the area is wild and hilly, with dense acacia bush, Greater Kudu, Reticulated Giraffe, Buffalo, Impala, Elephant, Kipspringer, Zebra, Bland, Dikdik, Waterbuck, Lion, Leopard, great bird watching and incredible scenery.



### TASSIA LODGE

Tassia Lodge, a complete and genuine ecologically friendly accommodation looks out over the Northern Frontier District towards Samburu, Shaba and the sacred Lolikwe Mountain. Tassia sprawls gently over a rocky bluff, which protrudes from the Mukogodo escarpment and overlooks a valley in which grow many Loimugi trees, a favorite food for the elephant that visit the area.

Tassia's extraordinary architecture is of Maasai tradition and is inspired by the surrounding natural area. Combined with the dramatic setting and the modern facilities and comforts of the lodge, this is one of the things that make it such an extraordinary destination.

## TANZANIA

**The Manor** The Manor at Ngorongoro is reminiscent of an elegant, upcountry farm house in the Cape Dutch-style of architecture with its luxurious of suite guest cottages. The Manor is the first luxury safari experience in the region to fuse East African Safari Hospitality with old world Afro-European architecture and décor.



**Lake Manyara Tree Lodge** is romantically exclusive with only 10 elegantly intimate styled tree house suites. Located within a remote corner of the reserve, Lake Manyara Tree Lodge is cradled within the boughs of an ancient mahogany forest. Furnishings and décor combine intricate details of luxury and the natural beauty of this incredibly breathtaking reserve and the cool leafy area that surrounds it.



**Arusha Coffee Lodge** lies in a tranquil coffee plantation, just outside Arusha, close to the Arusha airport and makes it an ideal stay for the start or end of a Safari to Ngorongoro and Serengeti. The small lodge has among the best rooms in Arusha, with a private atmosphere and personalised service, perfectly and most luxurious interiors, reminding of goneby days. Arusha Coffee Lodge was inspired by the grace and romance of a fine 'old-time' coffee plantation where guests could anticipate an accommodation of the highest standard.



### **Lobo Wildlife Lodge**

The Lodge offers 75 self contained guest rooms.



**Serengeti Migration Camp**
